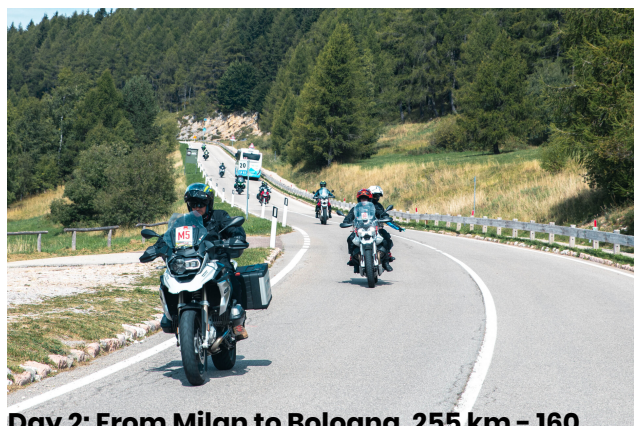

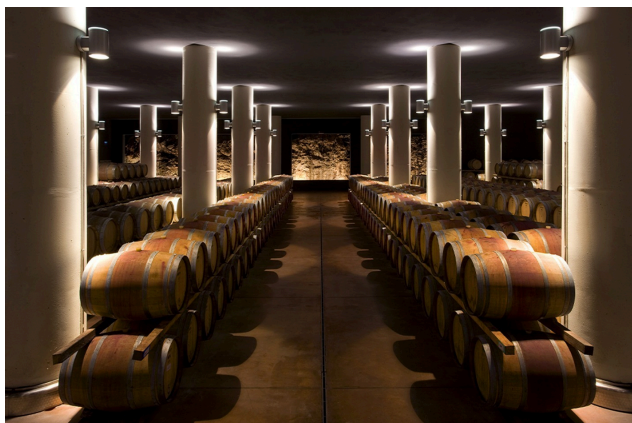
Day 1: Arrival in Milan (Hotel included)

PAYMENT TERMS:

- Up to 60 days before the start date, the deposit is kept as a credit for the following season for a tour or rental.
- From the 59th day to the 15th day before the start date, the deposit is forfeited. The balance is kept as a credit for the following season for a tour or rental.
- From the 15th day before the start date, 50% of the total amount is forfeited. The other 50% is kept as a credit for the following season for a tour or rental.
